ARREST: Assault update

Police have made an arrest in a Sept. 7 assault in the 7200 block of Cradlerock Way in Columbia. Police responded to the above location for a report of a fight where they learned an adult male victim had been cut by an acquaintance. The victim was transported to the hospital where he was treated and released. Through investigation, police identified the suspect and arrested him.
