Weapon violation

An adult male victim reported that he was approached by a male suspect who displayed a handgun and threatened him. The suspect then fled and dropped the gun, which was located and determined to be a replica. No one was injured.

SUSPECT: unknown race male in his late teens or early 20s, approximately 5'8" with a thin build wearing dark clothing
