Police investigating two-vehicle collision in Columbia

Three adults transported to hospital with injuries

Howard County police are investigating a two-vehicle collision in Columbia that resulted in serious injuries.

At approximately 5:30 p.m., a 2009 Honda Civic was traveling eastbound on Route 175 through the intersection with Dobbin Road when it struck a 1995 Toyota Camry that was traveling southbound on Dobbin Road.

The driver of the Honda, an adult male, and passenger, an adult female, were transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center with life-threatening injuries.

The driver and sole-occupant of the Toyota, an adult female, was transported to Howard County General Hospital with non life-threatening injuries.

Preliminarily, investigators believe the driver of the Honda failed to stop for a red signal. Charges have not been filed at this time. The investigation is ongoing.

Route 175 eastbound remains closed at Dobbin Road and Dobbin Road remains closed between 175 and Dobbin Center Way as police continue to investigate.
