Shooting

Columbia, 21044: 5300 block of Brook Way, Sept. 20 12:20 a.m.

Police responded to the area and located an adult male who had a non-life threatening gunshot wound. The victim was transported to University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center by ambulance, treated and released. There is no information currently available about a possible suspect. Police are investigating to determine whether the incident was drug-related. The investigation is ongoing.
