

**OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE FOR
PRIVATELY OWNED AND MAINTAINED
STORMWATER INFILTRATION BASINS**

(I-2)

1. The infiltration basin shall be inspected annually and after major storms. Inspections shall be performed during wet weather to determine if the facility is functioning properly.
2. The top and side slopes of the embankment shall be mowed a minimum of once per year, when vegetation reaches 18" in height or as needed.
3. Debris and litter shall be removed during regular mowing operations and as needed.
4. Visible signs of erosion in the facility shall be repaired as soon as it is noticed.
5. Remove silt when it exceeds four (4) inches deep in the forebay.
6. The bottom of the facility shall be rototilled at least once every two (2) years to insure that the soil maintains the infiltration capability.
7. A logbook shall be maintained to determine the rate at which the facility drains. The maintenance logbook shall be available to Howard County for inspection to insure compliance with operation and maintenance criteria.
8. Once the performance characteristics of the infiltration basin have been verified, the monitoring schedule can be reduced to an annual basis unless the performance data indicates that a more frequent schedule is required.
