
NEW! Home School In-Depth Study Fall 2020-Spring 2021

9 to 12-year-old home school students conduct in-depth study and cumulative investigations of nature and science topics. Classes are held once a month. Sign up for each season (3 classes) in which you have interest. **Fall Topics:** Investigate Earth Science (including geography, plate tectonics, rocks and minerals). **Winter Topics:** Explore Space (including gravity, deep space objects and the search for alien life). **Spring Topics:** Focus on STEM (while looking at sustainability in pollution control and energy-efficient design).
