**Shooting**

**Laurel, 20723:** 9100 block of Blues Aly, May 20 7:08 p.m.

Police responded for a report of shots fired in the above area. When officers arrived, they were unable to locate any suspects or victims at the scene, however, three cars had been struck. Police later learned that an adult male victim had been shot in the leg and transported himself to Laurel Regional Hospital. He was taken to Shock Trauma, where he was treated and released. The investigation is ongoing.
