



You can return your ballot by mail or you can drop off your completed, voted ballot at a drop box location in Howard County.

Simply place your completed ballot in the return envelope, sign the oath on the envelope, seal the return envelope and take it to a drop off box in the county.

Ballot drop off boxes will be delivered at different times. **The drop boxes will be available through Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>.** Your ballot must be dropped off by 8 pm on Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Please make sure your oath is signed on the return envelope or the ballot will not count.

Ballot drop off boxes are monitored and secured by trusted election officials. Ballots are retrieved from the boxes at least twice daily by election officials. The drop off boxes are not property of the United States Postal Service. If you have any questions, please contact your local election office.
