**Robbery**

**Laurel, 20723:** Pax Pharmacy, 9900 block of Washington Boulevard, May 25 11:45 a.m.

An adult male suspect wearing a motorcycle helmet entered the business, displayed a handgun and demanded prescription medication. The employees complied and the suspect fled. No one was injured. The investigation is ongoing.

SUSPECT: black male in his early 20s, 5'10", 170 pounds with medium-length dreadlocks wearing a motorcycle helmet and jacket, dark pants and tan boots

**Columbia, 21045:** 5800 block of Robert Oliver Place, May 25 5:35 p.m.

A juvenile male victim was walking at the above location when he was approached by three male juvenile suspects. One of the suspects asked to use the victim's cell phone to make a call, and when the victim started dialing, one of the suspects assaulted him and stole his phone. The suspects fled. No serious injuries were reported. The investigation is ongoing.

SUSPECTS: three black male teenagers, two wearing a black shirt and black pants and the other wearing an orange jacket and black jeans

Three male suspects with their faces partially covered gained entry to a residence by kicking in the front door. Once inside, the suspects approached two victims in the residence and demanded money.
