AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 14, after “OFF–PREMISES” insert “SALE AND”. In line 16, strike “LICENSE HOLDER” and substitute “PROPERTY OWNER”. In line 19, strike “CLASS C”. In line 20, after “ISSUED.”, insert “OFF–PREMISES CONSUMPTION SHALL NOT OCCUR IF THE BOARD DETERMINES THAT THE ADJACENT PROPERTY OWNER IS HOSTING A PUBLIC EVENT AT THE SAME TIME AS THE LICENSE HOLDER AND IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE LOCATION IN WHICH BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR WILL BE CONSUMED AND SOLD BY THE LICENSE HOLDER.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 24, strike “July” and substitute “May”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 23, insert:

“**23–1313.**

**(A) IN THIS SECTION, "ENTERTAINMENT VENUE" MEANS A FACILITY THAT IS USED AS A CINEMA, THEATER, CONCERT HALL, OR SPORTS STADIUM.**

**(B) THERE IS A CLASS C PER DIEM ENTERTAINMENT VENUE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.**

**(C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE CLASS C PER DIEM LICENSE TO THE HOLDER OF A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN AN ENTERTAINMENT VENUE THAT MEASURES AT LEAST 200,000 SQUARE FEET.**

**(D) THE CLASS C PER DIEM LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE**

HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES OF THE HOLDER OF THE PER DIEM LICENSE AND ON THE ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES.

(E) THE BOARD MAY NOT ISSUE THE PER DIEM LICENSE TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES UNLESS THE OWNER OF THE ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES PROVIDES THE BOARD WITH A STATEMENT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.

(F) LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 10 A.M. TO 11 P.M.

(G) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE LICENSE FEE.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, "ENTERTAINMENT VENUE" MEANS A FACILITY THAT IS USED AS A CINEMA, THEATER, CONCERT HALL, OR SPORTS STADIUM.

(B) THERE IS A CLASS D PER DIEM ENTERTAINMENT VENUE BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE.

(C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE CLASS D PER DIEM LICENSE TO THE HOLDER OF A CLASS D BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR USE IN AN ENTERTAINMENT VENUE THAT MEASURES AT LEAST 200,000 SQUARE FEET.

(D) THE CLASS D PER DIEM LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES OF THE HOLDER OF THE PER DIEM LICENSE AND ON THE ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES.

(E) THE BOARD MAY NOT ISSUE THE PER DIEM LICENSE TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON AN IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES UNLESS THE OWNER OF THE ADJACENT LICENSED PREMISES PROVIDES THE BOARD WITH A

**STATEMENT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.**

**(F) LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR MONDAY THROUGH SUNDAY FROM 10 A.M. TO 11 P.M.**

**(G) THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE LICENSE FEE.”**
