What is a Group Connection?

An opportunity for families to build social connections with each other, engage in parent child interaction and increase their knowledge of ways to support their child's development.



What does a Group Connection look like?



Parents receive a flier describing what the monthly group connection is about. Parents need to RSVP to let us plan for attendance.

Upon arrival, sign in, get name tags and find out where to go.

Each group connection is something different. There are many topics and activities for families to learn about making everyday moments, teachable moments for their children.

This an opportunity for parents and children to meet and get to know one another.

These opportunities allow children to work on creativity, hand eye coordination and fine motor skills.






Many offer physical activities to build strong muscles and to develop gross motor skills.
