A witness called police and reported that several juveniles were in a vacant home. The juveniles left before police arrived. Nothing was stolen.

The following arrests have been made in cases previously reported on the bulletin:

Arrest: Commercial robbery, Pax Pharmacy, July 20

Detectives have filed charges in a commercial robbery case from July 20 in the 9900 block of Washington Boulevard in Laurel. On that date, police responded to a report that two suspects, one of whom implied a weapon, entered Pax Pharmacy, pushed an employee, jumped the counter, stole prescription medication and fled. No one was injured. Through investigation, detectives have charged two juveniles as adults:

Maurice Andrew Porter, 17, of Buena Vista Avenue in Lanham, charged with armed robbery, robbery, first- and second-degree assault, theft and related charges.

Malik Gregory White, 17, of Pennsylvania Avenue in Forestville, charged with armed robbery, robbery, second-degree assault, theft and related charges.
