## **Impaired driving enforcement detail results in arrest of 14 drivers**

The Howard County Police Department conducted an impaired driving enforcement detail overnight, resulting in the arrest of 14 impaired drivers. Two additional drivers were taken into custody on unrelated warrants; another was arrested for drug possession.
