Police identify second pedestrian in fatal Jessup collision

Howard County police have identified the second pedestrian killed in Saturday's collision on Washington Boulevard.

Chawn Lamar Bryant, 18, of Philadelphia, PA, was identified after a family member made contact with police.

At approximately 11:14 p.m., a 2002 Honda Civic was traveling southbound on Washington Boulevard (Route 1) approaching Port Capital Drive when it struck the pedestrians, who were on the ground in the roadway. A witness reported the two victims were in a physical altercation in the travel portion of the roadway.

Bryant and Delcy Martinez Hernandez, 18, of Elkridge, were pronounced dead after being transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center following the collision.

The driver of the Honda, Zachary Jordan Tillett, 22 of Elkridge, and passenger, Rachel Elisabeth Aymold, 20, of Catonsville were not injured. No charges have been filed.

Washington Boulevard (Route 1) was closed between Route 175 and Montevideo Road for approximately three hours.

No additional details are available at this time; the investigation is ongoing.
