### **Two suspects in custody following armed robbery of grocery store**

Two suspects are in custody following the armed robbery of Weis Market in Woodstock this morning. Additional suspects remain outstanding.

At approximately 6:28 a.m., four suspects entered the grocery store in the 10800 block of Birmingham Way, approached employees and demanded cash. The employees complied and the suspects fled. No one was injured. Two of the four suspects were armed with handguns.

Police located the suspect vehicle, a gray Nissan Altima, leaving the area and pursued the vehicle into Baltimore County. With assistance from Baltimore County police, two suspects were taken into custody after the vehicle came to a stop near the area of Bloomsbury Avenue and Montemar Avenue in Catonsville. Police do not believe the outstanding suspects remain in the immediate area.

Police are looking into the possibility the suspects may be connected to a similar incident at the same grocery store on Dec. 18.

Arrest information will be released as it becomes available. No additional information is available at this time; the investigation is ongoing.
