

How to Recycle Rigid Plastics



Residential Curbside Collection

Residents with County-provided curbside recycling may set out rigid plastic items (totes, playsets, coolers, etc.) on their regular recycling collection day. Unlimited amount of recycling will be accepted.

Residents' Convenience Center at Alpha Ridge Landfill

Residents can place rigid plastics into a large roll-off marked "Rigid Plastic."

Please be advised, rigid plastics should not be placed into the compactors that collect single-stream recycling material.

Alpha Ridge Landfill is located at 2350 Marriottsville Road, Marriottsville, and is open Monday through Saturday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Acceptable

The types of plastics that will be accepted include (but are not limited to):

- ✓ Large toys (such as playhouses and swimming pools)
- ✓ Buckets (including buckets with metal handles)
- ✓ Milk/soda crates
- ✓ Laundry baskets
- ✓ Lawn furniture
- ✓ Coolers
- ✓ Totes and storage bins
- ✓ Drums/barrels
- ✓ Pet carriers
- ✓ Flower pots and trays (clean, no soil plant material)
- ✓ Water jugs (five gallon or larger)
- ✓ Recycling bins or garbage cans
- ✓ Shelving
- ✓ Automotive parts (bed liners, bumpers, grills, side-view mirrors, hubcaps, head lights and rear lights etc.)
- ✓ Pallets
- ✓ Trex wood

Not Acceptable

- ✗ Plastic clam shell containers
- ✗ Vinyl siding
- ✗ PVC pipe/tubing
- ✗ Styrofoam or polystyrene
