1. Administrative Items

- o Ms. Geckle stated that the minutes from the December 6, 2023, had previously been approved by the Commission via email.

2. Report of January 9, 2024, work session with the Council

- Ms. Geckle met with the Council to review the Commission's recommendations for legislation changes for the Citizens' Election Fund.
- The Council had some follow up questions for Ms. Geckle and are currently working on amendments based on the recommendations.
- o Ms. Geckle mentioned that the Council was pleased with the language of the recommendations.
- o The Council will allow the Commission the opportunity to review the changes

prior to them going through the legislative process.

3. Citizens' Election Fund ("CEF") Audit

- Ms. Moore confirmed the estimated cost of the CEF audit is expected to be between \$8,000 - \$10,000 and will be completed by the County's external auditor, CliftonLarsonAllen LLP (CLA).
- o CLA is currently reviewing the State Board of Elections (SBE) recommended audit items and will work with SBE during the process.
- o There is no expected date of completion at this time.

4. <u>Citizens' Election Fund Balance</u>

o The Department of Finance confirmed that the balance in the Citizens' Election Fund as of May 31, 2024, is \$1,470,572.54.
