Will I have to pay for emergency medical services transport at the time the services are provided? No form of payment will ever be expected at the time of service.

If I'm a County resident, will I receive a bill from the County for emergency medical services transport? County residents will NOT be billed for emergency medical services transport provided by HCDFRS. The County will bill patient insurance companies on their behalf.

Will I still receive emergency medical services transport and care if I have no health insurance? Absolutely! We are committed to providing top quality care to all who need it.

Will the new emergency medical services transport charge impact those who do not have the resources to afford such a charge? No. County residents will not be responsible for any costs not paid by their insurance.
