



## Rabies Vaccination Clinics

The Health Department and the Animal Control & Adoption Center hold monthly vaccination clinics to help you comply with County Code requiring vaccination to protect your dog, cat or ferret from the deadly rabies virus.

**Where:** Howard County Animal Control & Adoption Center

**When:** Monthly - 3rd Thursday, 12:00 pm - 1:30 pm

**Cost:** \$5.00 (cash or check)

### Information:

- Pets must be at least 4 months old to receive a vaccination.
- Animals may be vaccinated with 1 or 3-year vaccine based on prior vaccination history
- Bring a copy of previous vaccine history from a veterinarian. (3-year vaccination will be documented on the new certificate.)
- A County license for your pet may be obtained inside of Animal Control at an additional charge (\$6.00 for altered, \$24.00 for unaltered. Proof of spay/neuter is required for license).

**All pets must be on non-retractable leash or in an escape-proof carrier!  
Muzzles are required for aggressive dogs!**
