

Howard County COVID-19 Relief Rental and Utility Assistance

FACT SHEET

Maximum household income limits up to 80% of HUD area median income.

Beginning June 14, 2021, Howard County residents may contact one of the participating providers to apply for assistance to pay past due rent and utility bills. Maximum assistance per household may be up to 15 months of rent and utility expenses. Residents that previously received assistance are eligible to apply for additional assistance.

2. Applicant must provide evidence of loss of income due to COVID-related job loss, reduction in hours and/or medical illness.
