

FY 2021 CoC NOFO Program Competition

The Howard County Government Continuum of Care (CoC) program promotes community-wide collaboration and commitment to the goal of ending homelessness. The program provides funding for nonprofit providers and state and local governments to quickly rehouse homeless individuals and families while minimizing trauma and offering a comprehensive system of services, so that everyone has a safe stable home.

Howard County Office of Community Partnerships is seeking Subrecipient Applicants for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021 Continuum of Care (CoC) Program for Permanent Housing Projects for individuals and families experiencing homelessness. All applicants for renewal and new projects are required to submit applications. There is a separate application for each renewal/new project, and it will be forwarded to agencies that express interest in applying. Funding for new projects (created through Bonus, Reallocation, or Expansion) will be based on information prescribed by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for FY 2021. All data in renewal applications must be directly from HMIS/Service Point. Renewal or new projects created through reallocation, bonus or expansion, please submit a letter of interest to apply on or before **Tuesday, October 12, 2021, by 2:00 PM**.
