Program Eligibility



Your child must meet the following criteria:

- FARMS (Free or Reduced Meals) or SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Program) or WIC (Women, Infant and Children Program)
- Averaging a C in Math
- Scoring in the 40-60 percentile in Math



Program Logistics

This summer, the program will be located at Oakland Mills Middle School. The program will run from July 5 through July 29th Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 4:00pm. Tuesday, July 19th the program will be closed due to primary election day. Students will receive breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack. Transportation will be provided to those who need it and are not within walking distance to the school.

CLASS SCHEDULE

Enrichment will take place from 12-4

- Lessons will be embedded with focuses on Social and Emotional Learning, College and Career Readiness and Social Justice
- Enrichment options may include Creative Writing, Physical Health and Education, Media Arts, Visual Arts, Theatre, Music, Culinary Arts, STEAM, etc.
