Meeting Notes:

- 1) Welcome/Announcements
 - a. Area Plan Survey for the Office on Aging and Independence
 - b. This implementation project is a community-owned initiative, so you are encouraged to take ownership of the implementation, ask questions, and advocate for your role on the work group.
- 2) Continuing Review of Recently Updated Table
 - a. Work Group Members are encouraged to monitor implementation action items by attending and checking existing/ongoing Department of Transportation efforts and meetings (including the website), as well as volunteer your own ideas for action items/work group activities.
 - b. Circle back with Lyft regarding partnership with NeighborRide to provide concierge services – Bruce Fulton will attempt to reach out.
 - c. Transit Plan is available on the Department of Transportation
 - d. Looking for a Work Group member to explore alternative service delivery options (T2a) and doing some research on what services are available, may be beneficial, or how people connect to services (digital divide) OR have a Work Group member ask the Department of Community Resources and Services to explore these options.
 - e. Work Group is tasked with addressing need for Transportation Training (T5). This training is as simple as teaching people how to get on and off the bus and as complex as reading/interpreting the bus route system. This Work Group needs to identify which organizations are providing transit training or something similar. Terri has a lead from the Multi-Modal Transportation Board who may know about or be interested in providing transit training.
 - f. Reach out to 50+ Centers and the Police Department Community Liaison to coordinate more CarFit programs and Smart Drive Course (T8) and ask about their frequency and metrics behind these programs (e.g., number of people served, pre-post outcomes, etc.) to report impact in the Age-Friendly Report.
 - i. Terri will invite staff from OAI to present a couple slides to tell us about what and when driving/transit programs happen and who they serve.
 - ii. We also need to explore what programs or services are available to support people going through transitions away from driving (T9).
